Council Continuing Business

Multiple items of Continuing Business were addressed within the SEPTEMBER Council Meeting.

- Stewardship will be sending out the fall letter and commitment card in October for allowing members to consider their financial and time and talent giving for the upcoming calendar year 2025.
- Ken Grove is managing the collection of donations for notecards fundraiser for Matt Christensen, \$25 is suggested donation amount. This is entirely separate from donations to KoG.
- A church key audit has officially begun. Paper records are being converted to electronic files as well and those members listed as having key(s) will be contacted to confirm which keys are within their possession.
- Still pending: More revisions are needed to the Church Constitution within Chapter 13 for the sections that describe the composition and function of the Audit Committee. These updates will be presented at the next Annual Congregational Meeting in January, 2025.
- Still pending: plans for creating documentation of Church Inventory (Carolyn Jean Smith and Mary Rickerd).

LEAP/Veolia Task Force Report

LEAP/Veolia Task Force Report – for LEAP we have had to postpone the sale closing date again, due to city requirements regarding a sewer tap installation prior to filing with city and closing on PSA. However, LEAP provided KoG \$10K in earnest money which has been deposited in the Capital Improvements Fund. For Veolia, we are negotiating THREE Easement agreements: (1) Cross-Access for shared use of south entrance driveway (not done after Ustick Water Tank installation in 1980); (2) Access to new Community Well parcel; (3) Garden – for pedestrian access to KoG Community Garden. There have been delays because the attorney for Veolia has not been as responsive as we hoped.

LEAP is planning construction of the Sewer line across the north parking lot in late September or early October. The construction should make the north parking lot unavailable for use for about ten days.
