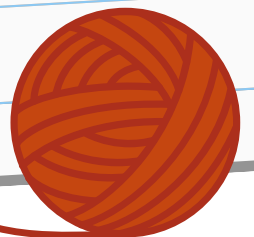
# Thank You

The neurosurgeon discovered she was not being given her seizure meds since 8/6/20 at St. Alphonsus acute rehab. Turns out during the 55 days she suffered countless seizures and is now being treated for delirium. They started her anti-seizure meds on 10/1/24. She is improving daily but may never recover. 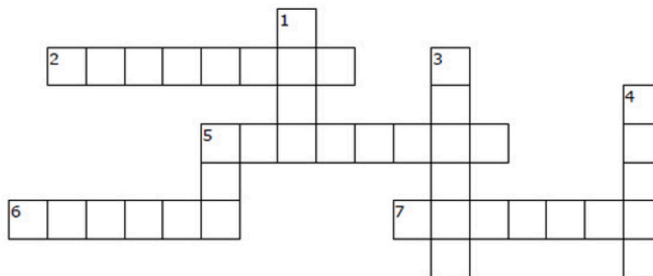
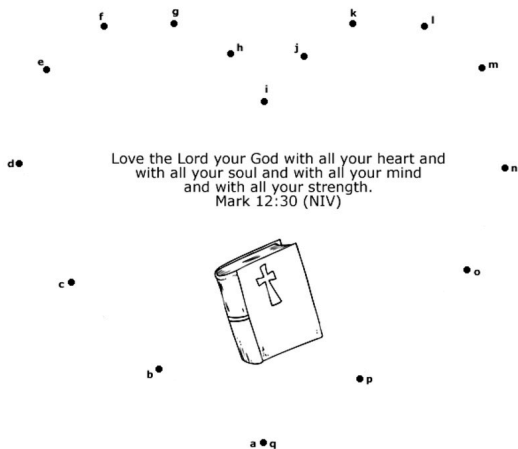
